### All Dog Show Guidelines Apply

Time of Arrival: after 4:00 pm/Departure Time: by 11:00 am

Dogs left unattended in a guest room must be in a crate. Plastic sheeting should be placed under each crate in the guest room area.

Housekeeping must be allowed to clean a guest room (with dogs) at least every two days. Guests who have special requests (i.e. a certain time of the day that the room will be vacant) can discuss them with the housekeeping staff upon arrival.

The individual guest will be responsible for any damage to a guest room or any hotel property. This includes, but not limited to, replacement cost of carpeting if odors or stains cannot be removed with traditional cleaning methods.

Dogs are to be leashed at all times when out of the guest room.

The hotel and the show committee will investigate any problem areas that are outlined above. Any guest not following the above guidelines will be asked to check out of the hotel without refund.

Dogs will not be allowed in the following public areas: the lobby, restaurant, lounge, Holidome and their respective hallways to the areas listed.

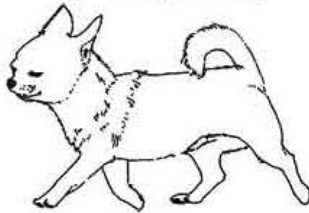
